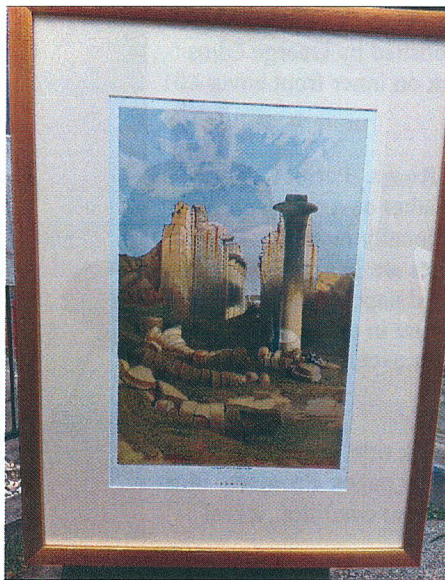
In 2010 I had the very good fortune to acquire some original first edition full page Folio prints from David Roberts' famous book *Egypt, Syria and the Holy Land*. 1842-1848. Since then I have sold two and have only two very fine prints left

Large folio print presented in landscape format titled "Fragment of the Great Colossus at Memnonium, Thebes." Framed in a large and impressive gold wood frame and crème matte. (see right) Price \$2999.

Large folio print presented in portrait format titled "Karnac" Framed in a stylish simple gold wood frame and crème matte. Price \$2600.

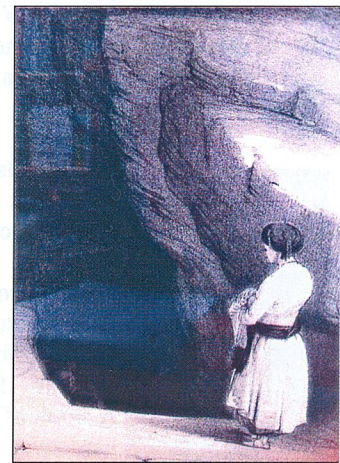
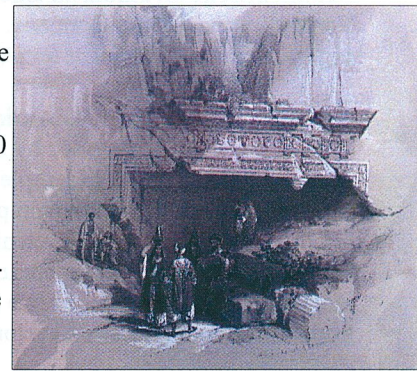


From another source I also acquired in 2010, four very rare prints, also David Roberts of the Holy Land. These four views are of...

- Fountain of Job, Valley of Hinnom #85 \$700
- Town of Tibarias, looking towards Lebanon #104 \$700
- Fountain of Siloam, Valley of Jehoshaphat #78 \$900
- Entrance to the tomb of the Kings. #84 \$700

I have since had them framed professionally in Ph Neutral grey mattes and dark wood frames (these set off the seina tones of the prints well)

These prints are now extremely rare and are highly Collectable. They are also currently on Ankh Antiquarian Books ebay page where you can see more colour photos of them.

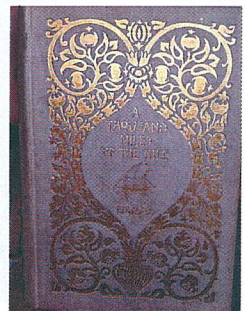


Detail of Fountain of Siloam ↑

The Great Pyramid It's Divine Message by Davidson D and Aldersmith H, 1932 (5th edition) revised. Hard cover with leather spine and raised edges with black and gold title. Cloth cover with leather corners, rebound at some stage. 568 pages with copious black and white foldout diagrams and details of the interior of the Great Pyramid of Cheops/Khufu of Giza. Rare in this exceptional condition. \$990.

Egypt Descriptive Historical and Picturesque by G. Ebers 1879 1st edition, 2 Volume Folio in very good condition, Published by Cassell, Petter Galpin and Co, London. Translated from the original German by Clara Bell. Vol 1, Brown buff cloth cover with gilt edges. Cover features gold lettering and stylized Egyptian Fans and Water plants, three lotus's in centre. Very attractive. Edges are slightly damaged and top of spine however in all in very good order. Interior endpapers in black, no foxing and all tissues intact, interior in excellent condition. Vol 2 same description as vol 1 except top and bottom edges of spine frayed and some glasses marks on cover. Internal Numerous etchings, maps, plans of temples and good well written text. A rare collectable and popular set of books. \$2000. (see next page for photos)
